

If schools choose Option 1, how do they decide where to integrate Phase One?

Phase One is taught in required courses, ensuring all students receive ACT prep instruction. Steps 1 and 2 will help you decide where to integrate each textbook.

- Each department lists courses every student is required to take for graduation. For example:

Required English Courses	Required Math Courses	Required Science Courses
English 9	Algebra	Physical Science
English 10	Geometry	Biology
English 11	Adv. Algebra	Science Elective
English 12	Math Elective	

- Each department chooses where to integrate each **ACT Prep** book. The grade you choose (9-11) doesn't matter. **Chose a course that every student takes that also matches the content of the ACT Prep book.** For example: Which ELA course covers grammar and punctuation? Add *ACT Prep: English* to that course. Which ELA course stresses POV or teaches critical analysis skills? Add *ACT Prep: Reading* to that course. Choose a course, not a grade. Individual schools have their own "best fit" solution for integrating *ACT Prep*.

- The **English department** might decide to integrate **ACT Prep: English** into the English 9 course and **ACT Prep: Reading** into the English 10 course.
- The **Math department** might decide to integrate **ACT Prep: Math** into the Geometry course.
- The **Science department** might decide to integrate **ACT Prep: Science** into the Biology course.

How does a school decide where to integrate Phase Two of ACT Prep?

Phase Two is implemented in grade 11 as most students take the ACT test in the spring of their junior year.

Each department must decide how to give every student the opportunity to practice ACT pacing and gain confidence.

For example:

- The English department adds mini ACT timed tests to its elective courses.
- The Math department offers mini ACT timed tests during chosen WIN periods.
- The Science department offers mini ACT timed tests during chosen homeroom periods.
